

Show Coordinator Report to the Board of Directors
June, 2013

A portion of the ribbons were ordered this spring:

Master Champions	(150)	\$890.00
Grand/Res Grand Does	(175)	\$4084.00
Grand/Res Grand Bucks	(150)	
Best/Res Best Wethers	(150)	

I will place an order for the JR/SR champion ribbons for both does and bucks the first of June. The ribbon inventory should last until next spring. It may be necessary to replenish the Master Champion ribbons before the fall shows. They are less predictable when it comes to how long the supply will last.

The National Champion Challenge trophies were ordered and sent to Maggie Leman. The cost remained the same: \$350.67

The numbers of events as well as the income (which reflects sanctions for future shows) for the first four months of the year show some increases:
