

PLEASE NOTE: CHANGES TO THE MASTER CHAMPION CHALLENGE

CLASSES AND OPEN SANCTION FEES FOR DOES AND BUCKS

The following motions were passed at the January 2020 Board of Directors meeting which change the Master Champion Challenge:

MOTION 2020-20 Fraser/Salmi carried 14-1 I move to amend Show Rules J:

1. Master champion classes will be available at all sanctioned open buck and doe shows. Sanction fees will cover the reports of award for each buck and doe master class. If ribbons are not needed, the show chair will check the box "no ribbons needed." Effective 04/01/2020 YES: Beaver, Carter, Chew, Coneybeer, Fraser, Griffiths, Howard, Hudson, Irving, Salmi, Shipley, te Grotenhuis, Woodward, Watkins NO: Seiler

It was brought to the attention of the board that motion #2020-14 did not address an increase in sanction to cover ribbon costs, as previously discussed during the meeting.

MOTION 2020-21 Watkins/Coneybeer carried 14-1

I move to increase open show sanction fees by \$10.00 for open doe and buck shows under rules for official shows section A.3 and the Application for NPGA sanction. Effective 04/01/2020. YES: Beaver, Carter, Chew, Coneybeer, Fraser, Griffiths, Howard, Hudson, Irving, Salmi, Shipley, te Grotenhuis, Woodward, Watkins NO: Seiler

How does this work? What does it mean? Effective 4.1.2020:

1. The sanction fees for Open doe and Open buck shows will increase from \$65.00 to \$75.00 if postmarked 60 days or more, from \$95 to \$105 if postmarked 59-31 days, from \$120 to \$130 if postmarked 30 days or less before the event. It will include paperwork for Master Champion classes. You will receive this paperwork, whether or not, you offer the classes.
2. The website will show MC classes being offered at every show, because that is the only way the results can be recorded by the Report of Awards Coordinator. (This is a function of the software.) As an exhibitor, you will have to check with the local show chair to see if they are offering master champion classes at a particular show. This remains the choice of the show chair or sponsoring club. Just because they receive the paperwork and/or rosettes does not obligate them to offer the classes. All other requirements for the classes remain the same, i.e., you must have 3 PGCH animals entered for the win to count.
3. As the show chair, if you want Master Champion ribbons to be sent to you, you will not have to do anything.
4. If you already have Master Champion ribbons, there will be a box to check that you do not need to have them sent to you.
