

NPGA AGENDA ITEM G

PROPOSAL:

Addition of (italics) to Show Rules G. 7

“At least six exhibitors must be represented at any show for a Grand Champion to earn a win. For purposes of meeting this requirement, each NPGA membership number shall constitute one exhibitor, or in the case of a nonNPGA member, the owner(s) of record on the registration certificate. *Only one membership number/name can be assigned to each animal for the purpose of counting exhibitors.* (effective May 1, 2000) (00-02, 00-03)”

REASONS:

Clarification of the existing show rules. Currently there is some confusion as to how to count exhibitors of an animal that is co-owned. If one animal is entered in a show but co-owned, currently there is some confusion as to if both owners count as separate exhibitors toward the exhibitor count for the show. This amendment will clarify the situation.

ADVANTAGES:

Clarification of the current show rule and help back up the intention of the rules already in place.
