The Spring issue of MEMO was reviewed by the Committee prior to publication.

Old Business:

At the January, 2019 Board meeting, the Copyright Ad-Hoc Committee was dissolved and the task to review the NPGA copyright rules was given to the Publications Committee. After reviewing, the Publications Committee recommends the following:

The current NPGA Rules and Regulations 15 Miscellaneous Procedures reads:

- D. The NPGA logo and all NPGA publications are copyrighted. Written permission from NPGA is needed to reprint or copy any article or section of an article from the NPGA website or any NPGA publication. Use of the NPGA logo by any person or organization for an unofficial NPGA purpose is not permitted for any reason. (08-09)

The Publications Committee recommends adding the following:

All requests for use of NPGA publications or logos shall be issued to the Publications Committee chair in writing. Email is an accepted form of written request. If granted, permission shall be for a one-time use only. The NPGA requires credit in any reprinted texts, graphics and pictures. To protect the integrity of our authors' work, we require that articles be reprinted unedited in their entirety. The NPGA has provided a Member logo and an Affiliated Club logo for use by members on printed items. Printed items will include checks, shirts, stationery, show ribbons, show programs and club signage. The *Link to the NPGA* logo is for internet use by members for their pygmy goat related websites and companies and entities that are goat related to link back to the NPGA.
