I have discussed with Linda Shipley moving some of the maturing CD's into a Money Market Account. Currently the money market account has an interest rate the same as a 1 year CD (currently .30%). If funds are put into a Money Market account we can watch rates and if a better rate becomes available, we can easily move the funds.

***Update: A Money Market account was opened on May 5th. Maturing CD for \$9,445.21 plus \$15,600 transferred from Checking was deposited to get best rate on Money Market account.*
