

Submitting Show Results

Please use the show results printed in 'The Pygmy Goat Memo' as an example for submitting your show results to the editor. However, DO NOT use any special formatting such as bold or italics on your text. Send your results as a digital MS Word Document (.doc or .docx) to npgaeditor@gmail.com. PDF or Excel documents WILL NOT be accepted. Simply type out the information in a single column, left-aligned, single spaced between placings and the goat's name with no tabs.

At the top of your document, please put the following:

Next, list the class placings. Begin with the class name, then put the number of animals exhibited in each class in parentheses (). If there is more than one show, put the number of animals exhibited in each show in parentheses separated by a comma without a space (x,x).

When there are two or more shows, list the animals in correct numerical order as they placed, **based on Show 1**. Put a space between each placing, then a space, the name of the goat, followed by a space, a dash, another space, and then the last name of the exhibitor. If there are multiple exhibitors with the same last name, use first initial followed by a period, then the last name.

If an animal placed in Show 1 then was shown in Show 2 but did not place, put a - (dash). If the animal was not shown in Show 2, or shown in Show 2 but not in Show 1, put a lowercase x.

If an animal wins a championship title, after the exhibitor's name put the championship in parentheses with an asterisk to tell in which show the win was awarded (JCH*). Use the following abbreviations in the class placings for the Champions:

Does & Bucks

Junior Champion = JCH
Reserve Junior Champion = RJCH
Senior Champion = SCH
Reserve Senior Champion = RSCH
Grand Champion = GCH
Reserve Grand Champion = RGCH

Wethers

Best Wether = BW
Reserve Best Wether = RBW

Showmanship

Grand Champion Showman = GCHS
Reserve Grand Champion Showman = RGCHS

The following examples show the preferred format for listing class placings. Pay close attention to capitalization and abbreviations. DO NOT type the word "Class" before each class name.

Instructions

Put the Class Name (number of goats in Show 1, number of goats in Show 2).

List class placings in numerical order based on Show ① placings.

Leave a space after Show 1 placings. | = a space. Then enter Show 2 placings.

Put a space after Show 2 placing, then enter the animal's full registered name with proper capitalization. DO NOT use all caps.

After the animal's name, put a space. Then a dash, another space, and the exhibitor's last name (Include the exhibitor's first initial if there are multiple exhibitors with the same last name in that show).

Examples

Final Version

The example above shows that four goats were shown in Show 1 and two goats were shown in Show 2.

Icing placed first in Show 1 and second in Show 2. She was shown by Smith and was the Junior Champion in Show 1. Misty placed second in Show 1 and first in Show 2. She was shown by K. Jones and won Junior Champion in Show 2. Ladybug placed third in Show 1, but did not place in Show 2. She was exhibited by Foster. Moana placed fourth in Show 1, but was not shown in Show 2. She was exhibited by Green.

Formatting Reminders

- Use the correct abbreviations to represent Championship titles.
- Use asterisks to represent in which show the animal received the title.
- Use a - (dash) if the animal was shown, but did not place in that show.
- Use a lower case x if the animal was not exhibited in that show.
- Combine titles with a / when the goat receives multiple titles in the same show (JCH/RGCH***).
- Separate titles with a comma when the goat receives different **titles** in different shows (SCH*, RSCH**).
- Separate asterisks with a comma when the goat receives the same title(s) but in two different shows. DO NOT retype the title abbreviations.
 - JCH**,** means the goat was Junior Champion in both Show 1 and Show 2.
 - SCH/RGCH**,**,*** means the goat was Senior Champion and Reserve Grand Champion in all three shows.
 - SCH/RSCH**,***, SCH** means the goat was Senior Champion and Reserve Grand Champion in Shows 1 and 3, and Senior Champion in Show 2.

Listing of Champions

Once the class placings are completed, continue on the same document and list all of the Champions. This is the information that will be published above the animal's picture. Use CH for Champion and RES for Reserve. Use S and D for Sire and Dam. All other words in the title are written out. Use ALL CAPS for the Champion title. List only the last name of the exhibitor, unless the first initial is necessary due to multiple exhibitors having the same last name at the same show. Please combine titles rather than listing the same animal multiple times. List animals by group in the following order: **Wethers, Does, Bucks, Masters.**

Instructions

Put the Title in ALL CAPS (Show #, Show #).

Put the animal's registered name with proper capitalization. DO NOT use all caps.

Use only an S: for Sire. One space after the colon. | = a space. Then list the sire's registered name with proper capitalization.

Use only a D: for Dam. One space after the colon, then list the dam's name with proper capitalization.

List the exhibitor's last name only (add the first initial if multiple exhibitors have the same last name).

Formatting Notes

Use RES with no period as the abbreviation for Reserve. Write out all other words in the title.

Title in ALL CAPS (Show #). Use CH with no period as the abbreviation for Champion.

Titles in ALL CAPS (Show #) for goats that also receive Grand Champion. Combine titles with a / when the goat receives multiple titles in the same show.

List titles when the goat receives different titles in different show (Show #). DO NOT separate show titles with a comma.

Examples

RES GRAND CHAMPION

JUNIOR CH DOE (2)

SENIOR/GRAND CH BUCK (1)

RES SENIOR CH DOE (1) SENIOR CH DOE (2)

Combine titles with a / when the animal received multiple titles in the same show (Show #). Then list titles when the animal receives a different title in a different show. DO NOT separate titles with a comma.

JUNIOR CH/RES GRAND CH BUCK (1) RES JUNIOR CH BUCK (2)

Separate show numbers with a comma, but NO space when the animal received the same title in multiple shows.

BEST WETHER (1,2)

Submitting Photos

Name the picture file the name of the goat. Shorten their name, leaving off the herd name, unless there are multiple goats with the same name at the show. Example: Whirlwind Farms Precision Built's photo should be named Precision Built. When possible, list photos in the same order as the Champions list. **Do NOT name the pictures by their placing in the show.**

Only send one picture of each Champion goat. There is no need to send the same photo multiple times if the goat received multiple titles.

All show results must be submitted to the editor digitally. They will be accepted via email, Google Drive, or DropBox. No results will be accepted via Facebook or Facebook Messenger.



New Separate Youth Show Results

In an effort to make our younger members stand out, Youth Shows will now be listed in a section separate from the Open Show results. All of the same formatting from above applies, just submit the Youth Show results as their own digital MS Word Document (.doc or .docx) instead of listing the results with the Open Show results. In the event of repeat photos from the Open Show, there is no need to send the photos multiple times. The only difference in formatting or submitting Youth Show results will be at the details at the top of the document.
